

Family and Reproductive Rights Education Program (FARREP)

FARREP is a Victorian initiative launched in 1998 to work towards the prevention of female genital cutting or circumcision (FGC)

FGC refers to all procedures to female genital organs for non-medical reasons, including partial or total removal of the external female genitalia.

The FARREP team at cohealth:

- **Support and advocate for women affected by FGC to get the best care and information about their health, and access to health services**
- **Refer women to appropriate health services and institutions,**
- **Work with communities, and provide information about FGC and the law in Australia for the prevention of FGC**
- **Provide cultural guidance, training and advice to cohealth and external health clinicians**

The cohealth FARREP team is experienced and trained community workers, who speak one or more languages used within the FGC affected communities.
